

Apprentice Lineman – Onawa

Western Iowa Power Cooperative (WIPCO) is currently seeking applications to fill an Apprentice Lineman position at our Onawa, Iowa office. This position will be available immediately or until position is filled. WIPCO is a rural electric distribution cooperative with approximately 2,100 miles of line and serves nearly 3,500 members in West Central Iowa.

Applicant must possess a thorough knowledge of electricity and electrical systems, ability to climb poles, and mechanical aptitude. Applicant must be able to construct and maintain both overhead and underground power lines in a safe and efficient manner. The ability to operate a bucket and digger truck, trencher, backhoe, cable plow, and various other equipment is also required.

Completion of a technical school Line Worker Program is preferred. First Aid/CPR certification and a Class A CDL are required. Pre-employment/post-job offer physical examination and drug test required.

Must be available during all weather conditions, to work on-call duties after hours, weekends, holidays, evenings, and other times outside normal work hours to assist in service restoration and/or other emergencies that may arise.

This position offers a comprehensive benefits package, including medical and dental insurance, 401K and retirement package, paid time off, and life and disability insurance.

Starting Apprentice Lineman rate is \$33.73/hour.
